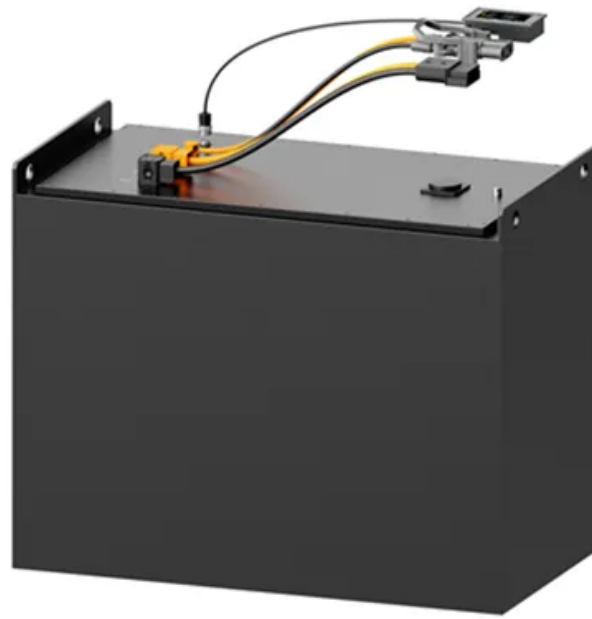

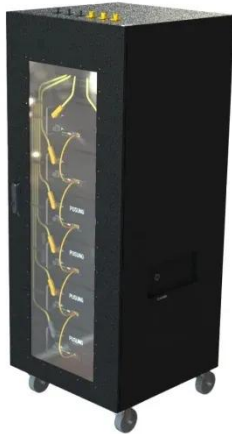

As of 2015 there are approximately 4,600 solar power systems operating in Bhutan, with 2,750 on-grid systems and



1,848 off-grid systems. The development potential is estimated at 12,000 megawatts.
