Bhutan's clean energy ambitions have entered a new phase of growth, marked by significant commitments from some of India's biggest power players — Adani, Reliance, and Tata — alongside a rising number of local renewable projects that are already feeding power into the grid. Implementation of Energy Efficiency (EE) measures in the country offers a great opportunity to enhance economic benefits by saving losses, increased domestic savings, reducing expenditures incurred on the import of fossil fuels and electricity during lean seasons. In addition, EE measures will also.

Bhutan's National Energy Policy 2025 (NEP 2025), released in June 2025 by the Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources (MoENR), represents a pivotal shift in the country's energy strategy. The combined ventures — including Adani's 570 MW Wangchhu, Tata's 600 MW Kholongchhu, and Reliance's 500 MW solar farm — are set to. Hydropower has long underpinned Bhutan's economy, contributing significantly to revenue and GDP. However, rising domestic demand, climate impacts and seasonal variability have exposed growing energy security concerns, particularly during winter months when domestic generation falls short.
