Brasília, Brazil | 26 August 2025 — Brazil has taken a major step forward in its clean energy ambitions as Petrobras, the Brazilian Development Bank (BNDES), and Finep jointly received 32 proposals for the Energy Transition and Decarbonization FIP. Brazil has positioned itself as a leader in the global energy transition. Its vast renewable energy resources, strong biofuels sector and ambitious climate commitments offer distinct advantages in the low-carbon economy. The country has introduced a comprehensive National Energy Transition Policy. The energy transition has increasingly taken center stage. It has become imperative to undertake profound changes in global, national, and regional energy matrices — replacing fossil fuel-based sources, such as oil and coal, with more sustainable, low-carbon alternatives, including solar, wind. 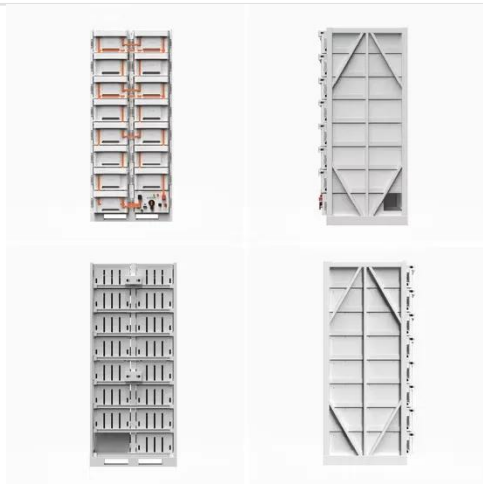
