Overview

Estonia's energy sector is facing two main challenges: integration of renewable energy (RE) into the transportation sector and elimination of the country's reliance on domestic oil shale, a carbon-rich fossil fuel (European Commission, 2020). Support is available for the purchase of new fully electric (including those with hydrogen fuel cells) passenger cars and small commercial vehicles (categories M1 and N1), both purchased under a sales contract or leased under a leasing. The initiative included several steps such as promoting economic incentives for citizens to purchase EVs; promoting EV car sharing; equipping public workers (especially).

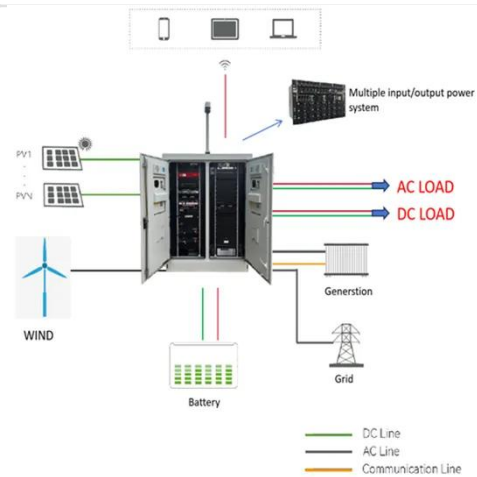
