

Is it illegal for a deaf person to install photovoltaic panels



Overview

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and other laws require governments, businesses and nonprofit organizations to provide access to people who are deaf, deafblind and hard of hearing. The access provided must meet the person's needs and how they communicate. Technically, no state outlaws or bans solar panels; quite the opposite. Most states have solar access laws that forbid any agreement, covenant, condition, bylaw, or contract that outlaws or limits solar installations by Homeowners Associations (HOA) or other municipal bodies. By establishing clear guidelines and regulations, solar access laws encourage the widespread adoption of solar energy and support the transition to clean and. Solar access laws can take different forms but include any law that protects your access to installing solar. For example, in 2022, the North Carolina Supreme Court and the Indiana legislature limited HOAs' power over solar panel installations.

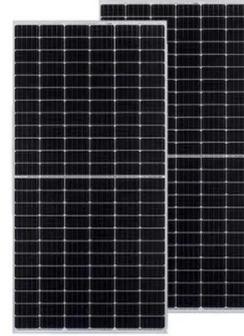
