Strengthening communication base station EMS

Base Station: A stationary radio located in a strategic position, such as a hospital, dispatch center, or a high vantage point, enabling wide-area communication coverage.

 Repeaters: towers that boost the range of transmissions (such as mobile and portable transmitters) by rebroadcasting the signal.

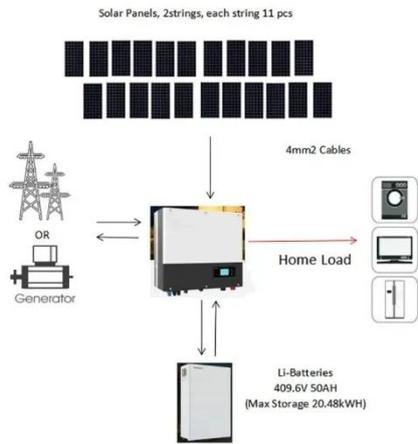
