Overview

Urban solar development is limited by building height restrictions, shading, and zoning ordinances that regulate installation visibility and tilt angles. Building to maximum height is especially common for flat-roof. Technically, no state outlaws or bans solar panels; quite the opposite. Most states have solar access laws that forbid any agreement, covenant, condition, bylaw, or contract that outlaws or limits solar installations by Homeowners Associations (HOA) or other municipal bodies. In some regions, lengthy permitting processes also discourage small and mid-scale solar adoption. Functional plans can either be part of a comprehensive plan or stand-alone documents.
