Overview

On 12 August 2025, Mauritania's Minister of Energy and Petroleum, Mohamed Khaled, announced a strategic renewable energy project with a total investment of \$287 million, aimed at expanding the country's clean energy capacity. A 5 million financing package from the African Development Bank and the Green Climate Fund will support two major projects that aim to develop solar power generation, transnational electricity interconnection and rural electrification in the country. The project includes a 160 MW photovoltaic solar plant in Nouakchott, a. Mauritania has taken a new step in its energy strategy, signing two public-private partnership agreements in Nouakchott on Friday, September 12, for the construction and operation of a hybrid solar-wind power plant. This pioneering project, the nation's first Independent Power Producer (IPP) contract, will be situated near the capital, Nouakchott. With a planned capacity of 60 MW, this.


