

The impact of anti-dumping on solar glass



Overview

India has imposed an anti-dumping duty on solar glass imports from China and Vietnam. While the intention was to protect domestic producers and support Indian manufacturing, developers worry this will escalate solar panel prices, impacting financial viability and project timelines. India's solar module prices and overall solar project costs are set to shoot up following the recent import duties on solar glass. The solar glass duty, largely aimed at supplies from China. 
