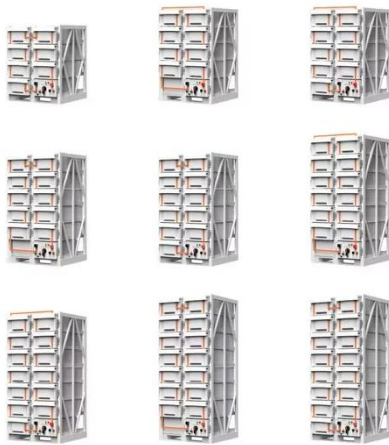

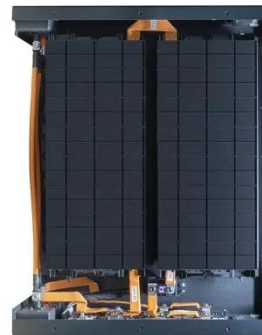
The trend of telecom subscriptions for the past five years shows an average
